As players of our club, you are to meet the following requirements with regard to the way you conduct yourself at training and at games throughout the season.

In your role as a player you are to:

1. Respect the rights, dignity and worth of fellow players, coaches, officials and spectators
2. Respect the talent, potential and development of fellow players and competitors. There is no "I" in team.
3. Refrain from conduct which could be regarded as bullying and/or victimisation, discrimination or sexual harassment
4. Participate fairly and safely.
5. Be frank and honest with your coach concerning illness and injury and your ability to train and play fully.
6. Conduct yourself in a responsible manner relating to language, temper and punctuality. Do not use profane language at any time.
7. Abide by the rules and respect the decision of the umpires. Be courteous and use the correct process when seeking a rule clarification.
8. Be honest in your attitude and preparation to training. Work equally hard for yourself and your team.
9. Co-operate and respect your coaches and manager in relation to programs that adequately prepare you for competition.
11. Applaud all good play, by your own team and opponents. Show good sportsmanship at the conclusion of a game by shaking hands and thanking them for the game.
12. Respect and acknowledge the contribution of those who create the opportunity for you to play (e.g. scorers, coaches, timekeepers, administrators and umpires).
